



Junior High School Supplies

Learning how to best organize their materials is a big part of the transition to junior high. Please talk with your student throughout the year and help them discover what works best for them. Below is a list of the classes for both 7th and 8th grades. Students will need a binder, loose leaf paper, pens and pencils for use in every class except PE and Art & Design. They may use one binder per subject or combine subjects according to their schedules.

Supplies may be brought with the students to Orientation on August 8. Students may find their lockers and put their supplies away. We will collect community supplies and put them away for use throughout the year in the junior high classrooms.

Junior High lockers may be modestly decorated on the inside. No lights, electrical equipment, outlandish, or obstructive decorations are allowed. A mirror, locker shelf, pen/pencil holder, and a few pictures are fine. These items may be brought to orientation along with supplies.

Other Items:

- **PE Uniforms** (required for non-football boys and all girls) - available for purchase in school office .
- **Spirit Shirts and other Spirit Gear** - available for purchase on the Parents' Association site (sfhswarriorgear.square.site). Junior High students can wear any spirit shirt with jeans or uniform shorts or pants on Fridays (SSJD = "spirit shirt jean day"). Jeans must be neat with no holes.
- **Boys Mass Tie**- regular or bow tie - available for purchase (\$15) from the school office
Boys are required to wear ties on Mass days.
- **Science & Design Lab Fee** (\$25) will be collected after school starts by the Junior High science teachers.
- **Art Fee (\$15)** will be collected after school starts by the Junior High art teacher.
